- Plan for, respond to and recover from any emergency, crisis and business disruption.
- Protect and minimize our impact upon the environment through pollution prevention and control, resource optimisation the maximisation of energy efficiency and the control, reduction and avoidance of waste.
- Ensure that employees receive appropriate training, and are competent to carry out their designated responsibilities.
